**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

This matter is before the court on a Petition for a Rule to Show Cause filed by the Receiver, through his counsel, on August 31, 2012 [Dkt. No. 5]. The Receiver has claimed a right to certain funds received by Small Farmer’s Journal, Inc. (“SFJ”), an Oregon corporation, which allegedly received proceeds from an illegal Ponzi scheme perpetrated by Ronnie Gene Wilson and Atlantic Bullion & Coin, Inc. *See United States v. Wilson*, 8:12-cr-00320-JMC. The Receiver contends that SFJ received a transfer of funds totaling at least \$586,400.00. However, the Receiver has been unable to locate any legal writings, contracts or other binding written instruments that support the transfer of these funds or otherwise establishes the legitimacy of SFJ’s possession of these funds.

THEREFORE, pursuant to the Receiver’s Petition for a Rule to Show Cause and for good cause shown, it is ORDERED that on or before September 21, 2012, Small Farmer’s Journal, Inc. shall provide this court all written documentation or evidence as to why it should not be required to repatriate profits acquired from the illegal Ponzi scheme. **SMALL FARMER’S JOURNAL, INC. IS CAUTIONED THAT FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE WITHIN ORDER COULD SUBJECT IT TO PENALTIES FOR CONTEMPT.**

The Receiver is directed to serve the within order on Small Farmer’s Journal, Inc., and to file proof of service with the court.
