The matter is before the court on the Receiver’s Petition to Liquidate Silver Holdings [Dkt. No. 9]. After consideration, the court finds that the Receiver has demonstrated good cause to immediately liquidate those silver holdings previously seized by the United States Secret Service and now under his control and to do all things necessary to liquidate said silver holdings. Specifically, the court grants the Receiver the discretion to liquidate the silver holdings after taking into consideration all factors the Receiver deems prudent, including the market price of silver, the cost of storing and transporting the silver, the transactional cost associated with any sale of the silver and the exercise of due diligence with regard to whom the silver holdings are sold. As such, the Receiver is hereby granted the specific authority to liquidate the silver holdings in his possession, consistent with those duties and responsibilities set forth in the Court’s July 25, 2012 Order [Dkt. No. 1].
